

46th Legislative District ~ Precinct Caucus Sites

The principal business of the 2006 precinct caucuses is two-fold:

1. the election of delegates and alternates to the 46th LD caucus (to be held on April 22nd) and to the King County Convention (to be held on May 6th), and
2. the discussion and action on platform issues and resolutions.

Residents who are registered to vote (or who will be eligible to vote Nov. 2006) are eligible to serve as delegates or alternates. **We encourage young people under 18 to attend and participate although they are not eligible to vote or serve as delegates or alternates.** The caucus give Democratic voters an opportunity to meet with other Democrats to discuss issues and to shape the beginning of the party's 2006 Platform. It also provides a forum for discussion of local, state and national public policies. We hope you plan to attend. Unsure about your precinct number? Each Precinct Caucus is individually convened at 2:00 p.m. All eligible attendees sign in, rules of the meeting are read aloud for all to hear, a chair of the meeting is elected by those attending, and a recording secretary is appointed. At approximately 2:30 p.m., the preliminary number of the Precinct’s eligible delegates is announced and the Precinct then elects its delegates. The members of the Precinct then consider issues and party philosophy, voting on and passing resolutions, as they want, to reflect the group’s views.
