Primary Election - Sept. 19, 2006

Please note the process for the Primary Ballot.

For voter registration information,  
call King County Records and Elections at 296-VOTE.

You will be presented with one ballot.  
On the ballot, you must indicate a Party with  
which you choose to affiliate,  
for this election only.

This section is private and no record of your  
choice will be maintained.

Then you may vote only in races  
corresponding to your party preference.

Don't forget to vote for the non-partisan races  
and ballot measures at the end of the ballot.

The steps for voting are simple.

1. Choose a Party.
2. Vote for Candidates within that  
Party only.
3. Complete the ballot by voting in the  
non-partisan contests and ballot  
measures even if you choose not to  
select a Party.

The 46<sup>th</sup> District Democrats make their endorsements  
based on a 2/3 vote of members and Precinct Committee  
Officers. Candidates were required to answer a questionnaire  
in advance.
