- **ARTICLE XVIII – RULES OF ORDER**

- In any situation not expressly covered by the rules of higher Party authority or these Bylaws, the latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order shall control – except to the extent those Rules are inconsistent with Standing Rules adopted pursuant to Article XII of these Bylaws and approved in the manner prescribed by Section 2 of Article XVII thereof.

Suspending the rules

- “Any request to suspend these rules for a particular race or ballot issue must be made prior to the consideration of that particular race or ballot issue. A 2/3 vote is needed for suspension of the rules. The requirement of needing a vote of 2/3 of the eligible voters present and voting for endorsement cannot be suspended.”
