### **Membership**

- 467 individuals (up from 420 on 4/21/05). Includes 77 contributing PCOs.
  - \* \$3 27 households
  - \* \$15 86 households
  - \* \$25 78 households
  - \* \$46 'Friends' 45 households
  - \* \$100+ 36 households
- Comparatively, we had 648 members on May 3, 2004, and 255 on May 6, 2003.

### **PCOs & PCO Appointments**

- 165 precincts are currently filled (59 vacancies).
- The District will have several PCO appointments to consider at our May meeting. Not all names may meet the deadline for being printed in the Demogram.

### **Area Coordinator Project**

- Thanks to Janet, we have Area Coordinators in all 14 areas. Attached is a 'cheat sheet' listing the Areas, Area Coordinators, Assistants, and the precincts/PCOs in each Area.
- Last week we sent separate emails from us and each Area Coordinator to all PCOs in their Area, introducing the Area Coordinator and sharing everyone's contact info.
