**RE: PCO/Membership Committee Report**

### **Membership**

- 521 voting members (up from 467 on 05/03/05)  
Includes 314 paid PCOs and/or members + 127 spouses + 80 additional PCOs
  - \* \$3                               28 households
  - \* \$15                               97 households
  - \* \$25                               93 households
  - \* \$46 'Friends'               54 households
  - \* \$100+                           39 households
- Comparatively, we had 726 members on June 1, 2004, and 258 on June 3, 2003.

### **PCOs**

- 3 precincts have been abolished:
  - 2248 is now part of 2247
  - 2250 is now part of 2249
  - 3423 is now part of 2152
- PCOs in abolished precincts remain in place until the 2006 elections and are eligible to vote.
- 173 precincts are currently filled (51 vacancies)
- 90 PCOs have made contributions to the District

### **PCOs & the June Nominating Convention**

Of our 173 PCOs,

- 109 PCOs are eligible to vote in King County District 1.
- 46 PCOs are eligible to vote in King County District 2.
- 18 PCOs are eligible to vote in King County District 4.

### **Area Coordinator Project**

Area Coordinators are working to help alert PCOs and members about the June 18 training and encouraging them to attend.

### **Training**

- Training is open to Members as well as PCOs.
- Promotion:
  - PCOs have received a Hold-the-Date memo.
  - A notice about the training is on the Website and in the May Demogram.
  - The June Demogram will contain a reminder notice.
  - ACs are helping on turn-out.
  - Flyers were available at the May meeting, and will be available at the June 16 meeting.
- To date, 15 PCOs have RSVP'd.
