

Resolution of the 46th District Democrats January 2007

WHEREAS, King County Councilmember Larry Phillips is a grassroots activist who has served as a Precinct Committee Officer (PCO) for his neighborhood since 1986 and who traveled to Ohio in 2004 to doorbell in support of the nationwide grassroots effort to put a Democrat back in The White House, and
