

**Resolution: Funding of the Iraq Occupation
and other Military Endeavors**

Whereas much of the cost of the invasion and occupation of Iraq has been funded by emergency supplemental bills which are not included in the federal budget; and

Whereas emergency spending is exempt from caps on discretionary spending, so that unrelated items are more easily added to the bills: and

Whereas the money spent on the Iraq war has essentially been put “on a credit card” to be paid for by future generations by these actions, combined with revenue loss because of tax cuts made during the time of the war;

Therefore, be it resolved that we call on Congress to insist that all funding for the occupation of Iraq – and all future conflicts - be included in the federal budget so that the effects of such spending on the entire budget will be scrutinized.
