Whereas 25,000 grocery workers at Albertsons, Fred Meyer, QFC and Safeway in the Puget Sound area have been bargaining for a new contract since March, 2010 and have negotiated in good faith, and

Whereas, in recent years, workers hours have been reduced to an average of 28 hours a week, and

Whereas workers deserve the basics of a living wage, health care, pension, sick leave and a predictable schedule, and

Whereas these workers are our neighbors and family members, and

Whereas the workers have voted an overwhelming 94% to reject the employers' offer,

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that the 46th District Democrats do hereby **SUPPORT GROCERY WORKERS** in **UFCW 21, IBT 38 and UFCW 81** in whatever actions are necessary to secure a contract that ensures their basic dignity as workers in our communities from Greenwood to Northgate, from Lake City to Laurelhurst, and throughout the 46th District, and

**Be it further resolved** that we commit ourselves to observe and respect any picket line(s) that may be set up in connection with such actions.
